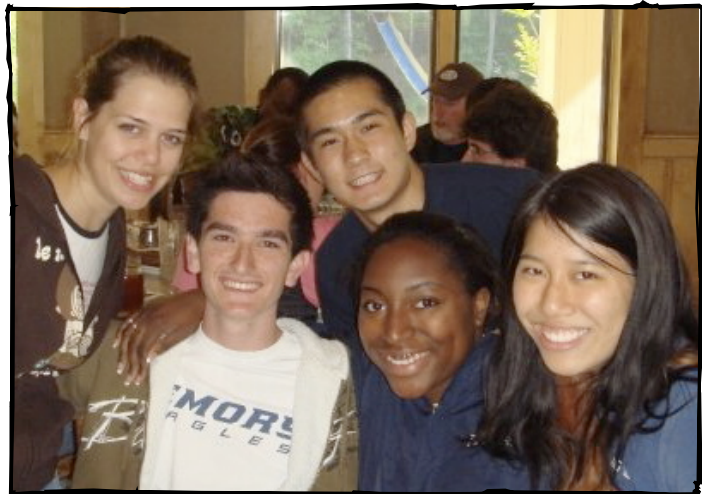


## Chapter Camp
